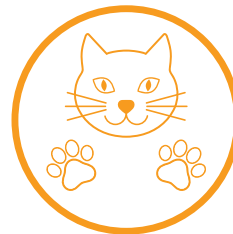

## EDUCATION



### HANEEN FIRDOUS

Haneen Firdous (HF), provides safe and empowering environment for young girls who come from socially challenging backgrounds. While our focus has been to ensure access to quality education, HF also provides various self-empowerment and religious activities to support them in achieving full potential. HF is licensed under JKM and currently cares for 10 girls.

### SOMALI REFUGEE LEARNING CENTER

Located in Gombak, the school started with only 14 students, growing to 75 students in 2022. The work force includes teachers from different refugee communities around Gombak including Somalia, Egypt, and Yemen. SRLC contributes to their education which is vital not only for their future, but also their self esteem and their contribution to society.





## HEALTHCARE



### KLINIK AMAL MUHAJIR

Together with our partner Hope Spring Charity, Klinik Amal Muhajir (KAM) has served over 9,000 patients over the course of 3 years, mostly refugees from conflicted and war zone countries such as Syria, Somalia, Yemen, Afghanistan, Myanmar, Yemen, Palestine and others. KAM provides healthcare services indiscriminately, regardless of religious beliefs, political ideology, race or gender.



Although the Medical Officers are hired to ensure continuity in service, KAM provides regular volunteer specialists including O&G, Ophthalmology, Family Medicine, Paediatrics, Orthopaedics, and Dermatology. Besides that, KAM has also become the source for medical aid, living aid and specialised medical /surgical aid for the community.

InshaAllah at KAM, we try our best to treat the vulnerable among us, far and near, as taught by Rasulullah SAW in his hadith :

“Seek out the vulnerable among you. Verily, you are only given provision and support due to your support of the weak.” Source: Sunan al-Tirmidhī



## DENTAL

### KLINIK PERGIGIAN AMAL MUHAJIR

Klinik Pergigian Amal Muhajir (DKAM) was established from the realisation that many of KAM's patients require basic but unaffordable dental treatment. DKAM has since, established collaboration with University Malaya Dental Faculty and Islamic Dental Association Malaysia to provide volunteer dentists. DKAM is currently operating 4 days a week providing basic services including dental health education to the refugee population.





## INTERNATIONAL

### FREE CLINIC at KG CHHNANG, PHNOM PENH

This free clinic for the poor and underprivileged families in Kg Chhnang Province provides medical services, circumcision, and health education programs. It is fully funded and managed by Little Steps with the help of a team of volunteers from Cambodia. The clinic also serves as a learning experience for visiting medical students.



### Yemen Community Rebuilding

All Yemen project is lead by our partner Hope Spring Charity, and we have contributed to the building of wells, maintenance of women halaqa groups, provided for food aids and medical aids. Medicare. Our projects in Yemen also include:

- Orphan support
- Anual Qurban program
- Winter support
- Yemen Water program

## Yemen Water

The temperatures in Tihamah (western coastal plain of the Red Sea) are probably some of the hottest on earth. Tihamah in Arabic means severe heat and lack of wind. Temperatures occasionally exceed 54 °C (129.2 °F)! In summer, the humidity from the sea makes the heat sweltering affecting children the worst. We have purchased water tanks and refill them a few times weekly since Rejab 2023. For RM150 per tank/per day can benefit hundreds of people InshaAllah. The tanks deliver water to Sana'a Marib and Tihamah areas eg Hodeida.





## ANIMAL WELFARE

### LITTLE PAWS CAT SANCTUARY

Seeing the many thin and uncared strays, Little Steps Charity has started a cat sanctuary to care for abandoned cats and prepare them for adoption.

Little Paws started fully operating in December 2022 and currently shelters more than 70 adult cats and kittens. All cats are fully monitored including vaccination, deworming, and various necessary treatment. LP also ensures a proper neutering or spaying process when necessary.

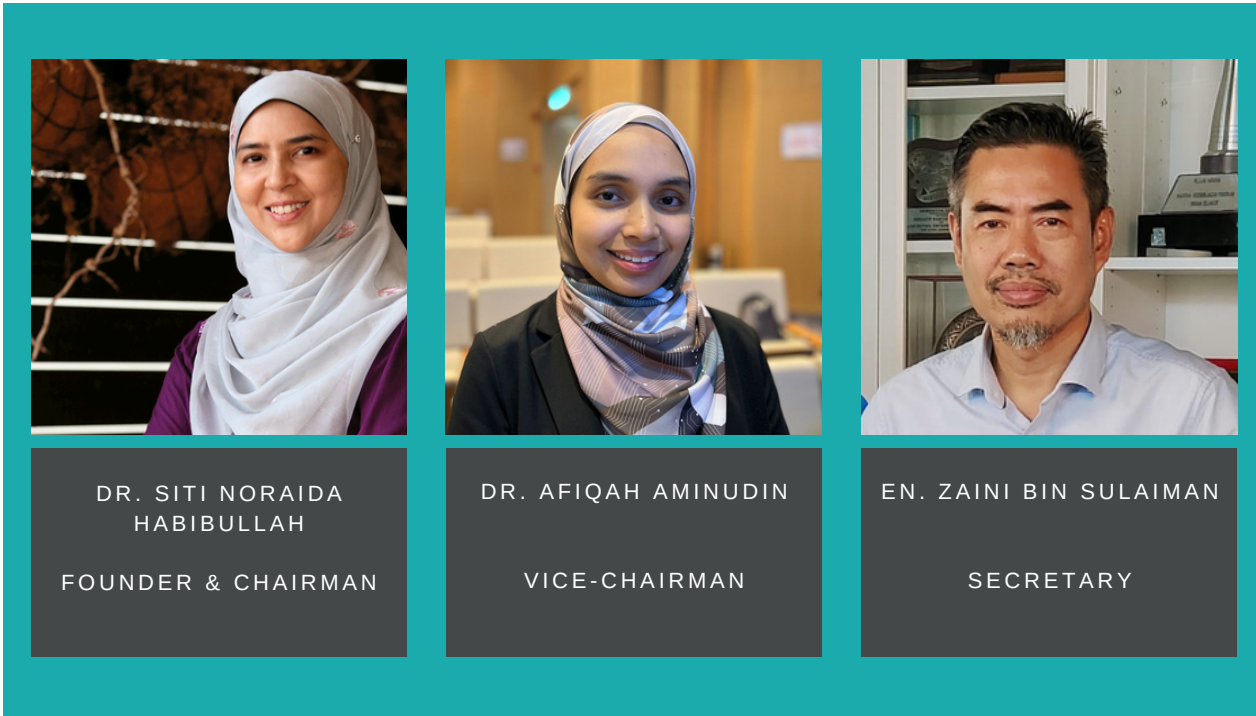
